PDE (Performance Driver Education)

Learn the art of driving fast in a safe and controlled environment with Pitt Race's seasoned pros, and then put it to the test. Train with Pitt Race's instructors on our natural terrain road course. The goal is for you to develop your skills behind the wheel as you experience a broad range of your car's performance. If you want to be a better driver with driving techniques based on racing, Pitt Race PDE is your source.

Test & Tune

Get some track time at Pitt Race! Perfect for testing that new build, scrubbing some tires, calibrating the brakes, and fine tuning your qualifying and race set ups.

All Test and Tunes will be full day. Participants will receive approximately 90 minutes of track time. No instructor feedback will be offered. Once the Pitt Race race-control officials know which cars are coming, the officials divide the cars into groups of similar configurations and speeds. The goal is to give every team and driver as much track time as possible.

Autocross

Autocross is a timed competition in which drivers navigate one at a time through a defined course on our Vehicle Dynamics Area (VDA). It is a form of motorsports that emphasizes safe competition and active participation. Autocross courses place demands on car handling and driver skill rather than on engine power and outright speed. Autocross differs from road racing and oval racing in that generally there is only one car on the track, racing against the clock rather than other cars. As an entry-level motorsport it provides a stepping stone for drivers looking to move into other more competitive and possibly expensive forms of racing (such as rallying and circuit racing).

Pitt Race offers two versions of Autocross. The first is our own Lowkey Autocross for novice drivers or those who are not as competitive. The second is run in conjunction with the Steel Cities Region of SCCA.

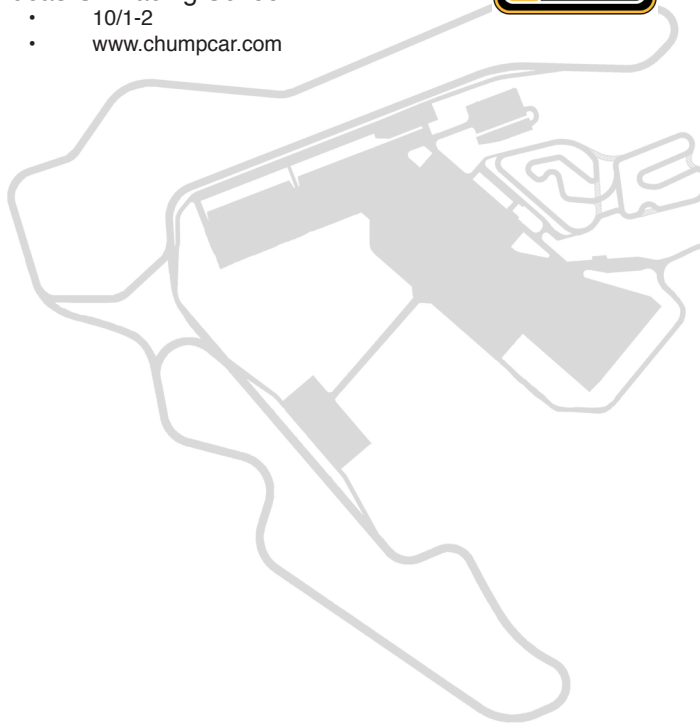

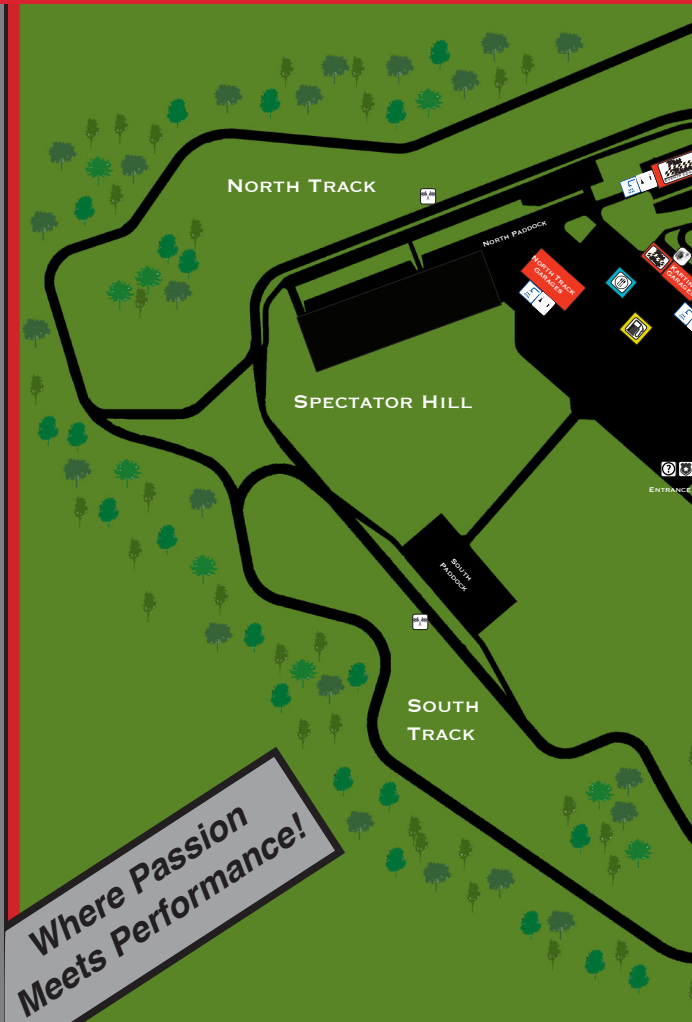


- 400-acre complex located in Wampum, PA, just off PA Turnpike, Beaver Valley Exit 13, 45 miles northwest of Pittsburgh.
- Full Circuit Track, 2.8 miles, 19 corners.
- Kart Track – .83 mile Wilson Circuit Kart Track provides a rush of excitement and is one of the fastest kart tracks in Pennsylvania. We have a full fleet of 9.5hp karts available for rental.
- Vehicle Dynamics Area – With a total area of seven and a half acres, our skid pad provides ample room for specialized training in performance and evasive driving maneuvers (including autocross and drifting) control critical to police, fire/rescue and security professionals, on-the-job drivers, and regular folks.
- Paddocks – Wide, fully-paved paddock areas are located easily accessible all tracks and comfort facilities. 120-volt, 30-amp electrical service is available throughout the facility. Paddocks are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Garages – Pitt Race has eight garages for rental adjacent to the North Track paddock area, and eight garages near our Events Center. Garage bays are 12 ft. x 12 ft., are equipped with roll-up garage doors.
- Food & Beverage – Concessions are available at Pitt Race during the season (April – October) on weekends and for most scheduled events. For corporate and special events, full catering services are available trackside and in our Events Center.
- Fueling Stations – Pitt Race features quality Sunoco Race Fuels in the following blends: 100 octane unleaded, 110 octane leaded, 98 octane ethanol-free unleaded, 93 octane unleaded

Emergencies and Security

In the event of a medical emergency, you may contact the EMS team at Medevac by dialing (724) 752-1413 from any phone. Guests may also contact on of our uniformed event staff or guards during any event for assistance. In addition, guests may go to the Pitt Stop Pro Shop for assistance.

Tune In

- Updates will be given over the public address system which is simulcast on 91.5 FM on any radio.

First Aid

- If you require medical assistance, the Pitt Stop Pro Shop is able to contact medical personnel during hours of operation. In the event of an after hours event, please contact the security guard at the entrance gate.

Lost and Found

- Lost and found items may be taken to or claimed at the administration office or the Pitt Stop Pro Shop. If you have been separated from or have lost someone in your group, please contact a track employee or uniformed security officer so efforts can be made to rejoin you with your party.

The staff and management at Pitt Race endeavor to create a safe, fun place for visitors and participants alike. Our facility was designed with your safety in mind...but this is a high-performance, high-speed venue. We want you to have fun and return again, so we ask that all visitors and racers follow the following rules:

Facility Rules and Regulations

- Waiver must be signed for each individual entering the track premises.
- Appropriate wristbands must be worn at all times while on track premises.
- No illegal Firearms, Fireworks or Weapons of any kind will be tolerated.
- No Drone usage
- Use wood or other suitable materials on pavement to avoid damages for trailer tongues, jacks, jack stands, etc.
- Promptly report all fluid spills on paved surfaces so that absorbent materials can be applied.
- Dispose of motor oils, brake fluids and antifreeze only in marked containers.
- All tires, scrap metal (including broken canopies) and any other vehicle parts must be taken with you and not disposed of at the track.
- Please be considerate of others by avoiding loud noise and music.
- For safety, please observe a 10MPH speed limit within the paddock areas.
- Help our friends and neighbors rest easy by observing our quiet hours from 8 pm until 8 am.
- Please help us keep the grounds clean by disposing of all refuse in the trash containers, conveniently located throughout the facility.
- All pets must be leashed and picked up after.
- No open campfires.
- No alcohol during hours of operations. No illegal drugs.
- Approved helmets must be for any on-track activity in excess of 45 MPH – no exceptions. For your convenience, helmets are available for rental.
- Failure to adhere to any of these rules is grounds for removal from the facility.
- No Smoking in any building including Garages
- Please dispose of cigarette butts in provided recepticals

Parking & Fuel

With more than 400 acres under development, Pitt Race has ample parking. Parking configurations are flexible depending upon the event and season.

On certain event days, our staff will be available to assist spectators and visitors to preferred parking locations. Team members and drivers will be directed to their assigned paddock and staging areas.

As a full-service motorsports complex, Pitt Race has an extensive trackside paddock area for vehicle staging. Electrical service (120-volt, 30-amp) is available in advance by calling 724-535-1000 or at the Pitt Stop Pro Shop on site. This is on a first come, first serve basis.

Eight garage bays are available for rental adjacent to the North Track Paddock which will service full size transports. Eight additional bays are available under the Event Center, with no large transporter parking. Bays are 12ft x 12ft, and are equipped with roll-up doors.

Pitt Race does not provide sanitary dump facilities.

Ready to take your karting to the next level? Book an Arrive and Drive event today! Perfect for anyone who wants to get involved in karting or see what it is like to drive a race kart. Pitt Race has four different classes available, which include:

SR. Rotax - \$450

You will be able to drive one of these race prepared karts on our track and receive personal coaching from one of our karting instructors. Call ahead to schedule your Arrive and Drive event.

FAQ

What if it rains?

We still run the rental karts in the rain. The only time we do not run the karts if it is a torrential downpour with pooling water or if we see lightning. This is at the discretion of the karting staff.

Do you race against the clock or against other drivers?

You race with your group for a total of 10 minutes then you will receive the checkered flag.

Are rentals always open 7 days a week from 12 – 8pm?

12 – 8pm is our normal rental schedule UNLESS there is an event taking place like a private group or a race event. It is recommended that you call ahead to double check on track availability.

How fast do the karts go?

Adult Karts – approximately 50 mph
Junior Karts – approximately 35 mph

What is the Height Requirement?

Adult Karts – 5 feet
Junior Karts – 4 feet

What is the Price?

Monday- Thursday

One 10 minute session - \$23
Three 10 minute sessions - \$55

Friday-Sunday

\$21 per session (single sessions only)

What do I need to bring?

You will need closed toed shoes, all other equipment that you need will be provided including gloves, jackets, helmets, and neck braces.

Open Practice

Looking to make some adjustments on your kart? Bring it out to our Wilson Circuit to Test & Tune your setup. Open practice runs 7 days a week from 8am-12 pm (Changes may be made without notice due to rentals), just like our rental karts. Cost: \$30 for the day on a weekday, \$50 for the day on the weekend. Open Practice will also run in 10-minute sessions and will alternate with rental kart sessions. If multiple classes are looking to practice, a rotation will be made depending on the class.

Track Announcements- Can be heard on 91.5 FM on your radio.

Lost and Found- Can be found at the Administration office and in the Pitt Stop Pro Shop

Office Hours-

M-F 8am-5pm

Event Weekends- 9am-4pm with variable acceptations. If the office is closed, the Pitt Stop Pro Shop will be open for all of your needs.

Packages- Packages delivered to Pitt Race can be picked up at the Administration building during regular office hours. During event weekends packages can be picked up at the Pitt Stop Pro Shop.

Gate Hours- 7am-6pm. This is variable per event.

Spectator Hill- The best access to view the racing on the full circuit can be obtained from the top of Spectator Hill. You may drive to the top of the hill and park in the designated area. Please do not pull off pavement or onto the viewing tiers.

Track Access- Walking access to the track may be permitted after the track has closed for the day. ***NO wheeled vehincles are permitted on track for tours including golf karts, 4 wheelers, bikes, skateboards, etc... Anyone using unauthorized vehincles on track will be immediately dismissed from presmises***
